■ Faculty of Economic and Business

■ Faculty of Agriculture

Faculty of Agriculture UGM is the first agricultural faculty in Indonesia established in 1947, which gives a lot of contribution to the agricultural development in Indonesia. Our faculty has 6 study programs: Agronomy, Agricultural Microbiology, Fisheries, Plant Protection, Agricultural Socio Economics and Soil Science. Excellent facilities are provided for supporting students education, not only laboratories facilities but also field facilities such as 1,100 hectares tea and cacao plantation (Pagilaran), upland and coastal experimental field and 35 hectares of Agricultural Experimentation, Research, and Development Station.

Our faculty has been actively participating AIMS program since 2012 (previously named as MIT program). The number for inbond program has reached 12 students coming from Thailand and Japan, and for outbond program, 21 students had completed AIMS program in Malaysia, Thailand and Japan.
